**1. Call To Order**

The meeting was officially called to order at 7:07 PM. PM. Members present were, Peggy Clendenon, Maria Hoffman, Nora Torres, Tommie Vermillion and Liz Gant. Charlotte Hernandez and Brandie Hunsaker were absent from this meeting. The KSB Commission has a vacancy at Place #2.

Seagoville High School Honor Society and Drill Team were previous participants that did not participate this year. Members felt that there was not as much litter as previous years, and the number of volunteers worked out OK for what there was to be cleaned up. Members felt that the event was well organized. There were several request for the wildflower seed packets that had been provided by the Dallas ISD Environmental Center the past two years. We will look for a source to be able to distribute the seed packets to volunteers for next year.

Members signed thank you letters for all the local businesses that contributed to the Trash Off. The 2010 Trash Off was funded by local business this year. The City of Seagoville spent about 5.00 in tax dollars on this year's event.

**4. Yard of the Month Program Kick Off Review**

Liz Gant reported that the KSB Commission had only received one nomination for yard of the month. Since there were no other nominations it was determined there was no need to review the yard nominated at 702 Putnam the home of Jim and Linda Norris. Hopefully, once the article appears in the Suburbia News other nominations will be received for future Yard of the Month awards.
