3. Conduct a Public Hearing and Consider Ordinance No. 06-10 Establishing Rules and Regulations Pertaining to Storm Water...

Jerry Yearout, 710 E. Simonds addressed the City Council and stated concerns about run-off on a bar ditch near his property. Mr. Yearout wanted to know if the storm water utility would alleviate the trash that flows into the bar ditch?

Public Works Director/ACM Mike Hitt stated the storm water utility program contained an anti-litter component designed to discourage littering

Joe Mitchell, 720 May Road addressed the Council and wanted to know if the storm water utility fund could be used to alleviate run-off and drainage on private property.

City Manager Denny Wheat stated storm water utility funds could only be used on public property along public easements and/or public thoroughfares.

Motion: Carl Polnac made a MOTION Peggy Day SECONDED to approve Ordinance No.06-10 Establishing Rules and Regulations Pertaining to a Storm Water Utility.


