CONSENT AGENDA

All consent agenda items are considered to be routine by the City Council and will be enacted by one motion. There will be no separate discussion of these items unless a Councilmember so requests, in which event the item will be removed from the Consent Agenda and voted on separately.

- A. Consider approval of the April 2, 2012 and April 16, 2012 Minutes.
- B. Consider approval of Resolution No. 14-R-12 denying Atmos Energy Corp., Mid-Tex Division's ("Atmos Mid-Tex") requested rate change requiring the company to reimburse the City's reasonable ratemaking expenses.

INDIVIDUAL CONSIDERATION:

- 1. Consider approval of Ordinance No. 03-12 annexing approximately 187.445 acres, more or less, of land extending the boundary limits of the city.
- 2. Consider approval of Ordinance No. 04-12 amending Chapter 9, Fire Prevention and Protection, by adding a new Article 9.04, Fireworks, of the Code of Ordinances by adding Section 9.04.001 (a) and (b).
- 3. Consider establishing a committee and appointing members to review the City's Sign Ordinance provisions.

Anyone wishing to speak before the Council during a Public Hearing will be required to fill out a Speaker Card and turn it in to the City Secretary prior to the Public Hearing. All comments and testimony are to be presented from the podium to the City Council. Comments may be limited to 3 minutes for time management purposes.

- 4. Hold a public hearing and consider Resolution No. 15-R-12 to approve the use of Community Development Block Grant funds for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2012, allotted to the City in the amount of \$93,392 for projects to be used for road rehabilitation in the Briar Creek Subdivision (Phase IV-B).
- 5. Conduct a public hearing and consider Ordinance No. 05-12 readopting, ratifying, republishing, and extending Ordinance No. 12.-06, codified as Article 13.06, Minors, Division 2, Curfew, for a period of three years.


CITIZEN COMMENTS
