4. Consider establishing a committee and appointing members to review the City's Sign Ordinance provisions.

Mayor Sexton established the committee and appointed Council Member Childress as Chair. He also placed Julio Torres and Jerry Becker on the committee. The following city staff will attend the committee meetings: Ladis Barr, Bekki Roberts, and Cindy Kintz. Mayor Sexton then received suggestions for the rest of the appointments to the committee from the City Council. Council Member Ashmore nominated Billy Chambliss; Council Member Landess nominated Gary Tedder and Dee Thompson. Mayor Sexton appointed those members and the full committee was formed.


