1. Call To Order

The meeting was called to order at 7:14 PM. Members present were Peggy Clendenon, Charlotte Hernandez, Alexandria Perez, Ann Marie Robinson, Gladys Santiago, and Liz Gant. The KSB Commission has two vacancies.

2. Approval of Minutes – March 18, 2014 Regular Meeting

Ann Marie Robinson made a motion to approve the minutes of the March 18, 2014 meeting. Charlotte Hernandez seconded and the motion passed with a unanimous vote.

3. 2014 Trash Off Wrap Up

Members discussed efforts made this year to grow the Trash Off event. One new group was involved this year. Planning practices implemented this year worked well: i.e. prior contact with local businesses, then follow up close to event. Four truckloads of trash were picked up and 124 volunteers participated. Thank you notes were written to each business that sponsored and all members signed. Gladys Santiago would like to add guest speakers in an effort to further our goals in the area of litter abatement.

4. Litter Abatement Discussion

a. Utilization of Court Ordered Community Service Volunteers

Members discussed the possibility of partnering with the Volunteer Center of North Texas as a source of volunteers, or asking the Seagoville Municipal Court Judge to assign volunteers to Keep Seagoville Beautiful specifically. Members reviewed basic information from North Texas volunteer Center. Further discussion will include liabilities, provisions for volunteers and supervision requirements.

5. Seagofest Parade 2014

Peggy Clendenon reported that she has not been able to make contact with the Dallas ISD Environmental Education Center Director, Paul Sugg to discuss the possibility of KSB partnering with the environmental Education Center for the parade. Ms. Clendenon would like to keep parade participation on the KSB Agenda.

6. Due to miscommunication the October Yard of the Month was not awarded.

Alexandria Perez made a motion to award the May Yard of the Month to the owners of the property at 718 Reeves. Ann Marie Robinson seconded and the motion passed with a unanimous vote.

8. Citizen Comments


