

Just the Facts on Disposal of and Large/Bulk Trash & Large Brush Pick Up



LARGE/BULK TRASH includes such items as stoves, refrigerators (*with all CFC removed*), water tanks, washing machines, furniture and other similar items, and, materials other than construction debris, large dead animals, hazardous waste or stable matter with weights or volumes greater than those allowed for bins or containers, as the case may be.

- Pick up of large / bulk trash is one (1) time per month and should be limited to a maximum of four (4) items.
- For providing specific collection cycles for each area of the City on a weekly basis, the City is divided into four (4) quadrants. A map is provided to each property owner that depicts the week of the month wherein their large/bulk trash is scheduled for pick up.
- All items MAY be placed at the curblines no earlier than 7:00 a.m. on Saturday immediately preceding the specified bulk collection week.
- All items MUST be placed at the curblines by 7:00 a.m. on the Monday of the specified bulk collection week. The actual bulk pickup day can be any week day of the bulk pick up week.



LARGE BRUSH is defined as unbundled brush that is larger than eight (8') feet in length.

- Large brush is picked up one (1) time per month using the same schedule as the Large/Bulk Trash above.
- Large brush stacks/piles shall be free of any and all foreign objects.
- Large brush shall not exceed six (6") in diameter, shall be cut to six (6') to eight (8') foot lengths, may be stacked loose with the large end facing the street in piles not to exceed five (5') feet in height.
- Feeder branches shall not exceed four (4') feet in overall width.
- Large brush may be placed at the curblines no earlier than 7:00 a.m. on the tenth (10th) day preceding the specified bulk collection week. The actual bulk pickup day can be any week day of the bulk pick up week.



PERSONAL RESPONSIBILITY shall mean the actions that you must take to ensure your Large/Bulk Trash and your Large Brush are picked up monthly as scheduled and that you are in compliance with all rules and regulations.

- Ensure you have placed the permitted items at the curblines for pick up.



- Ensure the brush is correct size.
- Ensure you have NOT deviated from any of the above stated regulations.



HELPFUL TIPS include other methods of disposal and other types of waste.

- The City of Seagoville Service Center, located at 101 N. Watson, is open every third (3rd) Saturday of the month from 8 a.m. to noon to provide Seagoville Residents with **free** access to dumpsters.
- Seagoville residential sanitation customers who provide a current water bill and valid TX photo identification as proof of residency are granted access to Republic Services ECD Landfill, located at 5703 N. IH45, Ennis, TX 75119, one time per month to dispose of non-commercial Acceptable Waste at a discounted rate of \$6.00 per cubic yard (with a minimum of \$18.00).
- Seagoville residents may call for pick-ups outside the specified week at a cost of \$80 per hour.
- Seagoville residents may dispose of paint, fertilizer, automotive fluids, lawn & garden chemicals, computers and other similar items **free** of charge at the Dallas County Household Hazardous Waste Facility located at 11234 Plano Road, Dallas, TX 75243.
