LOCAL MAN ARRESTED AND CHARGED FOR BUSINESS BURGLARIES

SEAGOVILLE, TX- During the early morning hours of 07/05/2019, a Seagoville Police Officer discovered a shattered glass door for a convenience store in the 600 block of Hall Road. Further investigation determined a total of three business in this small strip shopping center had signs of forced entry and the business were burglarized. Officers soon met with a representative of the convenience store that was summoned to the location. An officer was able to view the store surveillance video and quickly recognized the lone suspect as a known local offender.

Assisting Officers searched for and found this known suspect loitering around a business in the 200 block of N US Highway 175. He was carrying a backpack at the time of the encounter. Officers detained this suspect and found his backpack contained numerous items that included rolls of lottery tickets, packages of cigarettes, bottled drinks, rolled coins and currency. All of these contents were determined to have been stolen from these businesses during the commission of the burglaries.

Officer's arrested and charged NICHOLAS TROY KRAUSE, 21, of Seagoville for three counts of Burglary of Building. He is currently being held in the Dallas County Jail on \$30,000 bond for these collective charges. He is also being held without bond on two probation violations for previous theft convictions.
